Fredrica is a teacher, author, and scholar of Anglican church history and theology. Her current title is Mary Wolfe Professor Emerita of Historical Theology at Episcopal Divinity School. Her latest books are *In Conversation: Michael Curry and Barbara Harris* and *Looking Forward, Looking Back: Forty Years of Women's Ordination*.
